

## MAXIMIZING YOUR EQ3 BASS DRUM MUFFLER

Take that pillow out of your kick and never put it back. The EQ3 provides superior bass drum muffling without compromising the resonance of the drum the way more bulky methods will. Lightweight, easily installed and electromagnetically charged to absorb higher-end sound frequencies, the EQ3 gives a rich bass sound that features the desired tonal purity AND quicker decay that often eludes drummers with more conventional mufflers. With the EQ3, you can be basking in a great sounding bass drum in a matter of minutes. Here's how:

1. Remove the backing on each of the Velcro retaining strips on the bottom of the EQ3, exposing the sticky adhesive surface.
2. Dependent on which head you prefer to muffle, place the EQ3 on the floor of the bass drum resting the flap against the batter or resonant head. The angle at which the flap rests on the head will dictate the degree of muting provided. For those who prefer more muffling, position the EQ3 so that more of the surface area of the flap rests against the surface of the head. Those who like a little more resonance will opt to pull the EQ3 back so that less of the flap rests against either head of the drum.
3. Strike the batter head of the bass drum with either pedal or stick to make sure you have the EQ3 resting in a position that generates your desired tone.
4. Once certain of your tone, set the EQ3 in place by pressing **firmly** along the length of the pad to affix the Velcro strips to the floor of the bass drum.
5. You can now remove your EQ3 with ease by simply pulling it from the strips which will remain attached to your bass drum shell. Should you ever wish to reset your EQ3, the strips can be pulled off the shell but will likely lose their adhesive quality. Replacement strips can be purchased from your Evans dealer.
